SPRING & SUMMER HAPPENINGS AT ST. BONIFACE

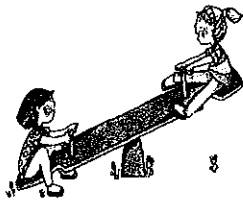
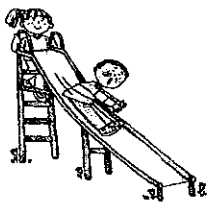

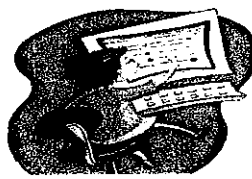

BARTON ROAD TO BE CLOSED

Due to Bridge Structure Rehabilitation by PennDot, the road will be closed from the beginning of August and should be completed by mid October. Detour on Lake Pleasant, Tate Road and Route 8 will be in affect for approximately 2 months after the start of construction.

NATIONAL NIGHT OUT - AUGUST 4, 2015

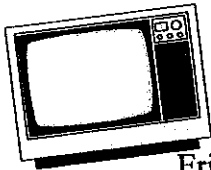
