


**GREENE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

MARCH 9, 2015**




1. Donated use requests were reviewed.






PAYMENT OF CURRENT BILLS Motion by R. Allgeier, second by L. Vallimont to pay current bills, motion carried (3-0).
