


**GREENE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

JULY 13, 2015**


In attendance were Supervisors Richard F. Allgeier, Jr., Linda M. Bliley and Lisa A. Vallimont. Worksession commenced @ 3:30PM. Topics of discussion were as follows:

1. AMark Environmental will begin removal of asbestos from the boiler and pipes the first week of August.
2. R. Allgeier stated that paving continues. Once the paving is done, sluice pipe changes will begin.
3. L. Vallimont stated that she was contacted by DCNR for additional information for the grant application. Parks & Rec continues to work on public awareness for the renovation of Playground Paradise.
4. L. Vallimont stated that we have been awarded the National Night Out grant from United Way again this year. NNO will be held on Tuesday, August 4.
5. A draft uniform policy as presented by L. Bliley was reviewed. This will be placed on the agenda for the regular monthly meeting.
6. A draft employee handbook as presented by L. Bliley will be reviewed individually by the board and discussion will follow at a later date.
7. Mark Srnka and Lisa Vallimont will not be attending the Flagger Training due to recycling. L. Vallimont will process the cancellations.
8. L. Vallimont has requested attendance at the PAMA Conference in Bethlehem, P. Koehler has requested attendance at two PA Rural Water courses.
9. Extended leave and continuation of benefits was discussed.
10. Mark Srnka has requested that the board begin to consider purchasing a new recycling truck. Mr. Srnka feels that the recycling program is in need of some upgrades with the truck being the most important.

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING  
JULY 14, 2015**

The public meeting was called to order by Chairman R. Allgeier at the Municipal Building commencing at 7:00 PM. Following the salute to the U. S. Flag, roll call was taken. Those present were Supervisors Richard F. Allgeier Jr., Linda M. Bliley and Lisa A. Vallimont.

**ADOPT AGENDA** Motion by R. Allgeier, second by L. Bliley to adopt the agenda with the addition of i. sewer collection update under Old Business, motion carried (3-0).

**MISCELLANEOUS FROM THE FLOOR/PUBLIC COMMENT** Rita Postlewaite inquired about employee status of B. Johnson, C. Magee and R. Greene. Robert Kazmaier inquired about the road grinding project. R. Allgeier stated the following: that we had approximately 6 miles of road done at an approximate cost of \$60,000 and that the priming took a little longer than planned due to weather; there was some overtime required for flagging; the paving and seal-coat have begun; an emergency pipe repair was done on Jordan Road and; Summit Township swept our seal-coat areas.

**MUNICIPAL REPORTS** R. Allgeier presented the June 2015 Road Superintendent, Tate Rd Building, Planning and Zoning reports. Reports and minutes will be available for inspection at the end of the meeting or at the office during regular business hours.

**OLD BUSINESS** Chad Hanley, of HRG, presented the Consulting Engineer's Report. Mr. Hanley also gave the board two copies of a Grinder Pump Agreement – one for township maintained and one for property owner maintained. The board will review the agreements to decide the best option for the township. Esther Hubert inquired about the subdivision Mr. Hanley spoke of and it was explained that we will have to subdivide four parcels where the pump stations will be located on private property; the fifth pump station will be located on township-owned property. Randy Slomski asked for a brief synopsis on the plan. Robert Kazmaier asked how we determine the cost to be paid for the subdivided property. Jeanette Edinger inquired about the cost of the system. It was suggested that the Act 537 Plan be put on the website.





**SUBDIVISIONS/SEWAGE MODULES** None


**UNIFORM POLICY** No action will be taken at this time. Further discussion will be held at the August worksession.




