


**LETTER OF RESPONSIBILITY** R. Allgeier read the Letter of Responsibility that will accompany the PennVEST application.

**ADOPT AGENDA** Motion made by L. Vallimont, second by L. Bliley to adopt the agenda, motion carried (2-0).


