

**SANITARY SEWER NOTICE TO PROPERTY OWNERS
RECEIVING GRINDER PUMPS**

Please Read the Following:

Construction of the sanitary sewer system adjoining your property will be started in the near future. Your property is proposed to be served with a grinder pump unit.

If you have signed and returned the grinder pump agreement – Thank You.

If you have not signed and returned the agreement, it is imperative that you do so immediately. The Township will be paying for the installation of grinder pump unit and the connection to the system. You will only be responsible for the connection from your house to the grinder pump and the power connection. **If you do not sign the agreement, the Township will still require your connection to the system as per the Township Ordinance; however, you will be responsible for the cost of the grinder pump and the connection to the system.**

In order to avoid misunderstandings and provide the best service for you, we request that you place the attached flag at the location you wish for your new grinder pump unit. Some important items to note are:

1. Consult a qualified plumber to determine your best grinder pump unit location. The Township's Contractor will install the grinder pump's discharge line generally using the shortest distance from the pump unit to the sewer main.
2. Consult a qualified electrician for your electrical connection needs.
3. Information (plans) on the location of the sewer main alignment for your property is available at the Greene Township Building. The plans are available for review during regular business hours.
4. Be mindful of the path your building sewer will need to take in order to connect to the grinder pump unit.
5. Once you determine the best location, push the flag into the ground where the contractor can see it. This location, according to the Grinder Pump Agreement you received, must be a minimum of 10 feet and a maximum of 40 feet from the building to be serviced.
6. The depth of the grinder pump inlet pipe (the gravity line that will be used for your connection to your property) will provide for lowest floor service.
7. If you do not place the stake in the ground, the sewer line contractor will choose a location on the lower side of your property within the limits per the agreement.
8. You will be asked to sign the sketch of the location created by the field rep once the pump is installed.
