

Process for Tapping Into The Sewer System

1. Review the enclosed information
2. Choose a plumber or contractor (and an electrician if you have a grinder pump), if you're not doing the connection yourself.
3. Fill out the Application to Connect to the Sanitary Sewer System. Bring the application and \$4,750 to tap-in to the system to the Greene Township office at 9333 Tate Road, Erie, PA 16509, and get a Connection Permit.
4. Fill out the Connection Permit, and request a date and time for the free inspection of your ditch connecting your house to the sewer main or grinder pump.

You must give AT LEAST 48 hours' notice to schedule an inspection

The ditch must not have water in it when the inspector comes

5. If you fail the inspection, you will be charged \$50 for a follow up inspection
6. If you want an inspection at a time outside business hours, that can be arranged for a fee of \$35, depending on the inspector's availability.
7. Once the connection is approved, the inspector will approve the tap-in, and you will be added to the billing list at that time.
