REGULAR MEETING

7:00 P.M. ROOM 102


The public meeting was called to order by Chairman Richard F. Allgeier Jr., at the Municipal Building 9333 Tate Road, commencing at 7:00 P.M. following the salute to the U.S. Flag, roll call was taken. Those present were Supervisors Richard F. Allgeier Jr., Linda M. Bliley and John D. Bartnicki.


- I. Richard made the **motion** to adopt the agenda John seconded, motion passed (3-0).
- II. One comment from the audience recognizing Richard F. Allgeier Jr., as the recipient of the Pennsylvania Snowmobile Club Award.
- III. Richard made the **motion** to approve the minutes of April 9 work session and April 10 regular meeting, seconded by Linda motion passed (3-0).
- IV. John made the **motion** seconded by Linda to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills subject to audit, motion passed (3-0).
- V. Municipal reports were presented, and stated they are available for review during office hours Monday through Friday 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
- VI. Chad Hanley gave an update on the sewer project, payment of request number 10 in the amount of \$26,241.68, payment of request number 7 of phase II in the amount of \$289,106.31, and payment of request number 4 for phase III in the amount of \$5,640.18. Richard made the **motion** seconded by Linda to pay all payment applications presented, motion passed (3-0). Chad stated that HRG will assist Greene Township with the closing of the phase IV PENNVEST funding on June 27, 2018.
- VII. Linda made the **motion** seconded by Richard to hire Lindsay Grignol for the part time assistant treasurer and bookkeeper, motion passed (3-0).
- VIII. Richard made the **motion** seconded by John to accept the diesel fuel bid from Melzer's for \$44,650, for 19,000 gallons, motion passed (3-0).
- IX. After review of three bids, it was **motioned** by Richard and seconded by John to award the bid to Suit-Kote in the amount of \$36,855 for 31,500 SY of reclamation at \$1.17 per SY, motion passed (3-0).
- X. After review of four bids from the same companies, a **motion** by Richard seconded by Linda to award McCormick the bid of 9.5 mm asphalt at a cost of \$51.00 per ton (1,000 tons), for a total of \$51,000, and the bid of 19 mm at a cost of \$47.75 per ton (6,600 tons), for a total of \$315,150. Motion passed (3-0).
- XI. Flagger training will be held here at Greene Township May 24, 2018 from 9-noon, Richard made the **motion** seconded by John to send all Greene Township employees to the training, motion passed (3-0).
- XII. John made the **motion** seconded by Richard to approve Emilio Vasui pond as presented, motion passed (3-0).
- XIII. RESOLUTION 18-2018 eminent domain proceedings for the acquisition of easements in Greene Township, for the public purpose of providing public sewer service to the properties located in Greene Township, **motion** by Richard seconded by Linda, motion passed (3-0).
- XIV. **Motion** by John seconded by Richard to hire BIU (Building Inspection Underwriters of Pennsylvania, INC.) effective May 9th, 2018, motion passed (3-0).


- XV. Motion** by Richard seconded by Linda to renew the IU5 (Intermediate Unit) contract for lease space at the Greene Township building from July 2018 through July 2019, motion passed (3-0).
- XVI. Motion** by Richard seconded by Linda to approve the donated use request from the parks and recreation commission for June 6th, from 4-10 pm for a paint night through sassy canvas, as a fundraiser for playground paradise.
- XVII.** Several residents commented on the parking along the side of the road on Kirsch road by the apartments, residents asked if signs can be posted. The Supervisors will review the ordinance about roadside parking.
- There are several concerns about Morehouse road, Kirsch road, Knoyle road, Hartman road, and Haft road, as to when or if they will be paved, it was explained that tonight Hartman road was approved to be reclaimed, and the other roads will be repaired as soon as the contractor is finished.
- There are some water issues on Kirsch road, it was suggested to look at the water system that is currently serving the lower end of Kirsch and see if that could be extended up to Old Wattsburg road.

Being there was no further business the meeting closed at 8:01 by Chairman Richard F. Allgeier Jr.
