REGULAR MEETING


MAY 22, 2018 3:30 P.M. ROOM 102


The public meeting was called to order by Chairman Richard F. Allgeier Jr., at the Municipal Building 9333 Tate Road, commencing at 3:30 P.M. with the salute to the U.S. Flag, roll call was taken. Those present were Supervisors Richard F. Allgeier, Linda M. Bliley (via speaker phone) and John D. Bartnicki.


- I. Richard made the **motion** to accept the agenda seconded by John, motion passed (3-0).
- II. There were no comments from the audience at this time.
- III. Dollar General plans were presented for final review and approval from the Supervisors, after review John made the **motion** seconded by Richard to approve the plans as submitted, motion passed (3-0).
- IV. Richard made the **motion** to approve the subdivision plans as presented by Cheryl Lorei, seconded by John, motion passed (3-0).
- V. RESOLUTION 19-2018 Agility between PENNDOT and Greene Township, **motion** by Richard, seconded by Linda, motion passed (3-0).
- VI. **Motion** by Richard seconded by Linda to send John to a Parks Trails and Recreation meeting Wednesday May 23, 2018 at the Erie County Planning Department, motion passed (3-0).
- VII. **Motion** by Richard seconded by Linda to send John to Microsoft Excel training on June 26, 2018 at the convention center at a cost of \$79.00, motion passed (3-0).
- VIII. **Motion** by Richard, seconded by John to send employees to confined space training at a cost of \$1,500, motion passed (3-0).
- IX. It was reviewed that the grant to the United Way for National Night Out has been submitted.
- X. Richard made the **motion** seconded by Linda to approve Northeastern Environmental LLC., at a cost of \$3,850 to remove the tile and mastic in rooms 204 and 203, and have Mark place new tile, motion passed (3-0).
- XI. **Motion** by Richard seconded by Linda to allow PSSATS to hold a CDL class here Tuesday September 11, 2018 from 9 am to noon, and 1 to 4 in room 104, free of charge, motion passed (3-0).
- XII. Parks and Recreation would like to use the gym, kitchen, room 102-104 July 18-22 for feeding the crew and possible child care for the week of the build, free of charge, motion by Richard seconded by Linda, motion passed (3-0).
- XIII. Parks and Recreation would like to use the gym and kitchen on June 10, 2018 for a spaghetti dinner as a fundraiser for playground paradise. **Motion** by Richard, seconded by Linda, motion passed (3-0).
- XIV. General conversation over the pavement of several roads Horseshoe, Haft, Kirsch, Woodrose, Hartman, Bliley, Peck, it was stated that these roads will have more attention this year due to the sewer project on most, and that Hartman and Bliley parts will be reclaimed as opened and approved at the Supervisor meeting on May 8, 2018. Traffic counters have been placed on Peck and Bliley it was reviewed that 329 cars travel that area on average.
