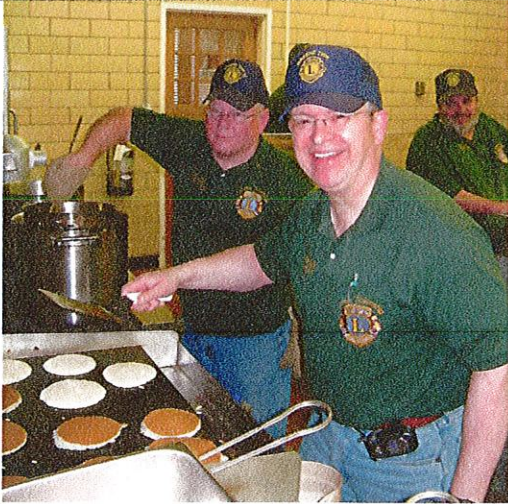


LIONS KNOW HOW TO MAKE BREAKFAST
