REGULAR MEETING  
August 14, 2018 ROOM 102

The public meeting was called to order by Chairman Richard F. Allgeier Jr., at the Municipal Building 9333 Tate Road, commencing at 7:00 P.M. with the salute to the U.S. Flag, roll call was taken. Those present were Supervisors Richard F. Allgeier Jr., Linda M. Bliley, and John D. Bartnicki.

- I. Richard made the **motion** to accept the agenda seconded by Linda, motion passed (3-0).
- II. There were no comments from the audience at this time.
- III. Richard made the **motion** to accept the minutes from the July 24 meeting, seconded by Linda, motion passed (3-0).
- IV. Richard made the **motion** to approve and pay all bills subject to audit, seconded by John, motion passed (3-0).
- V. Subdivisions/Sewer Modules, none at this time.
- VI. Municipal reports were read, and are available in the Township office for review Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
- VII. Sewer update, several payment applications were presented to be paid as follows; Phase I payment application # 14- FINAL in the amount of \$77,344.25, Phase II payment application # 12 in the amount of \$268,252.00. Richard made the **motion** seconded by John to pay the applications presented, motion passed (3-0).  
Substantial completion for Phase II could be this coming Friday, substantial completion is the completion of installing sewer pipes and final completion is the point when restoration work is complete. Phase III is well under construction and is on track according to the schedule.

- IX. **Motion** by Richard seconded by John, pending authorization from HRG, authorization to send Tap-In notices for Phase II customers. Motion passed (3-0).
- X. RESOLUTION 27-2018 **Motion** by John seconded by Richard to file eminent domain for the acquisition of easements, for the purpose of providing public sewer service. Motion passed (3-0).
- XI. **Motion** by Linda seconded by Richard to adopt Connection Specifications dated August 14, 2018. Motion passed (3-0).
- XII. Linda made the **motion** seconded by John to allow National Fuel to use room 104 from noon to 6:00 p.m. on August 28, for a communications class. Motion passed (3-0).
- XIII. Richard made the **motion** seconded by John to allow the boy scouts for use the gym for a moving up ceremony from 5:00 to 9:00 p.m. on August 28. Motion passed (3-0).
- XIV. Residents had some time to voice their concerns about Kirsch road and Horseshoe roads, when will they be paved, and yards be fixed from the sewer project? There is a plan by the Township to repair the roads, every road can't be done all in one year.
